**GRAMMY NOMINEE CHARLIE WILSON'S THIRD SOLO ALBUM
"JUST CHARLIE" IN STORES TODAY**

Debut Single "You Are" No. 1 At Urban AC
Album Features Collaborations With Kanye West, Fantasia



(New York, NY) — Everyone’s favorite uncle, and 2010 Grammy nominee, is back. **Charlie Wilson**’s third solo album **Just Charlie** is in stores today and is already receiving critical accolades. *Entertainment Weekly* praises **Wilson** and states, “his velvet vocals still run smooth.” *USA Today* adds, “how distinctive **Wilson**’s silky voice is.” *Dallas Morning News* observes, “His voice remains potent. Time has further enhanced his talents.”

His current single “**You Are**” (← Click to listen) is currently No. 1 on the Urban Adult Contemporary chart. When the single debuted at radio earlier this fall, it gave **Wilson** his biggest career debut on both the Billboard Urban Adult Contemporary Singles chart and the R&B/Hip-Hop singles chart. “**You Are**” is his third No. 1 single on the Urban AC chart. His previous singles “**Charlie Last Name: Wilson**” spent six weeks at No.1 and “**There Goes My Baby**” spent nine weeks at No. 1 and was also the most-played single in 2009 on the chart.

Kanye West, the Insomniac and Gregg Pagani—who produced **Wilson**’s “**There Goes My Baby**”—are among the other producers collaborating on the album. Noteworthy features on the album include **Fantasia** joining **Wilson** on a spirited cover of **Zapp & Roger**’s “**I Want to be Your Man.**”

Just Charlie is the follow-up to his critically acclaimed 2009 album **Uncle Charlie**. The sophomore set earned two 2010 Grammy Award nominations for Best R&B Album and Best Male R&B Vocal Performance for “**There Goes My Baby.**” The album resided on the Urban Adult Contemporary Albums chart for more than a year after debuting at No. 1 on the R&B/Hip Hop Albums chart. Those feats led to **Wilson** being crowned Billboard’s 2009 Urban AC Artist of the Year. **Wilson** also received a 2009 Soul Train Icon Award from BET.
